WHO WE ARE

OUR MISSION

The Junior League of Norfolk-Virginia Beach (JLNVB) is an organization of women whose mission is to ADVANCE WOMEN'S LEADERSHIP for MEANINGFUL COMMUNITY IMPACT through volunteer action, collaboration and training.

OUR VISION

We are an organization of diverse women CREATING A POSITIVE IMPACT on the lives of women and children in South Hampton Roads.

OUR HISTORY

Since its founding in 1901 by social activist Mary Harriman, The Junior League has evolved into one of the oldest, largest, and most effective women's volunteer organizations in the world, encompassing MORE THAN 125,000 WOMEN in over 295 LEAGUES IN FOUR COUNTRIES. For more than a century, The Junior League has been on the FOREFRONT OF SOCIAL REFORM, identifying problems — pollution, illiteracy, domestic violence, foster children without a safety net — and finding solutions.

JLNVB was founded in 1925 and was the FIRST JUNIOR LEAGUE in the Commonwealth of Virginia. We are a diverse group of OVER 300 WOMEN who are committed to our mission. Our purpose is exclusively educational and charitable. For nearly a century, JLNVB has been A FORCE FOR CHANGE in our local community as a result of the tireless and innovative work of our trained members.

OUR COMMUNITY IMPACT AREAS

JLNVB utilizes its diverse group of women and funding to support its own community programs and also provide volunteers, financial support, Board representation, and training to organizations and community projects that are aligned with our two key impact areas, CHILDHOOD LITERACY and WOMEN'S HEALTH. The identification of these impact areas was based on 18 months of research conducted by our Community Impact Development Committee.

CHILDHOOD LITERACY: The National Assessment of Educational Progress, also known as NAEP or the 'Nation's Report Card', highlighted the severe learning loss endured by American children since the pandemic. Virginia was hit particularly hard. According to the Virginia State Superintendent, Virginia saw the most severe drop in reading test scores in the entire country. Only 32% of Virginia's 4th graders performed proficiently in reading compared to 43% in 2017. Our goal for this impact area is to promote childhood literacy through programs and initiatives that decrease the number of functionally illiterate students in Hampton Roads, and to encourage family reading at home through increased access to books.

WOMEN'S HEALTH: Women's health is an impact area that resonates deeply with our membership because we are an organization of women, but also because of the prevalence of women's health issues and the stigmas often attached to them throughout the community. These issues include mental health, reproductive and menstrual health, maternal health and more. Our goal for this impact area is to lower risks and improve general wellbeing for women in Hampton Roads through various programs and initiatives that provide education, awareness and access to resources.

SIGNATURE COMMUNITY PROJECTS

The Junior League of Norfolk-Virginia Beach's diverse group of community projects address the needs of the Hampton Roads community within our two impact areas and also help engage our League members by providing a wide range of volunteer opportunities.

ELEVATE TO EDUCATE

At Elevate to Educate, our volunteers help to create a more dynamic learning environment for elementary students in Hampton Roads by making over a local Title I elementary school with educational murals, improved landscaping, playground updates and more! Following the makeover, JLNVB continues supporting the school with two years of custom programming focused on literacy and women's health! In March 2023, JLNVB began its comprehensive makeover of Ingleside Elementary by power washing its buildings, adding outdoors games on sidewalks, painting rails, doors and murals to brighten up the school, and redesigning the teacher's lounge.

LITTLE LIBRARIES

JLNVB partners with a variety of local organizations and schools that promote childhood literacy by providing them with funding, supplies and volunteers, organizing book drives, and working directly with children to promote reading and life-long learning. JLNVB also constructs, paints and stocks free little libraries for installation across Hampton Roads. Four little libraries were donated during the 2022-2023 league year. During the pandemic when public libraries were closed, JLNVB launched Book it to Bedtime, a virtual storytelling program. Members recorded readings of different children's books, creating a "virtual" Little Library.



WOMEN'S HEALTH INITIATIVES

JLNVB regularly uses its funding to assemble and distribute women's health packs to local schools and women's shelters. These include period packs, pregnancy kits and other health essentials. JLNVB also regularly runs food drives and supplies volunteers to local food banks and community centers that provide meals and other essentials to the community.



VOLUNTEERING IN THE COMMUNITY

JLNVB promotes voluntarism of its members by providing a variety of volunteer opportunities across the Hampton Roads community. Recent volunteer opportunities have included:

Participating in the Teddy Bear Clinic at the Virginia Zoo where children could bring their favorite stuffed animal to the Zoo for a check-up to demystify visiting the doctor's office and show them the importance of regular medical care for people and animals.

Representing JLNVB at Kindfest in August 2023. Kindfest brings the Hampton Roads community together to support local causes, make our world a kinder place, and help our community thrive.
